

September 21, 2009 meeting,

The Town of Franklin Board of Aldermen had a special meeting on Monday, September 21, 2009 at 5:30 P.M. in the Town Hall Board Room. The purpose of the meeting was to consider the transfer of property to Macon County as part of the Little Tennessee/Cartoogechaye Creek sewer line project. Mayor Joe Collins presided. Aldermen Verlin Curtis, Jerry Evans, Joyce Handley, Billy Mashburn, Carolyn Pattillo and Bob Scott were present.

Transfer of property

Sam Greenwood said when the Little Tennessee/Cartoogechaye Creek sewer line is put on line the Belden pump station will become unnecessary and will be removed. He said there is one tenth of an acre of property that the pump station sits on now. He said Macon County needs the Town to transfer this property so that they can transfer it later to Jim VanderWoude. A copy of the plat is attached.

Motion was made by Evans, seconded by Handley to declare the one tenth of an acre of property designated Town of Franklin #0116457 as surplus and to deed it to Macon County. Motion carried. Vote: 6 to 0.
