The Town of Franklin Board of Aldermen had a special meeting on Wednesday, April 26, 2006 at 5:00 P.M. at the Town Hall Board Room. Motion was made by Evans, seconded by Pattillo for John Henning, Jr. (town attorney) to send a letter to Peter and Shirley Robes that the effluent from their RV Park will not be accepted into the sewer line on Highway 441 north until the punch list is completed or a firm understanding of the status of the punch list with a definite time set for completion is reached. Motion carried. Vote: 6 to 0.
