Presentation of Proposed 2006-07 Town budget

Mike Decker went over the proposed 2006-07 budget with Mayor Collins and the Board. Copies are attached. Alderman Scott said instead of doing across the board raises we need to give the same amount to each employee. He said the lower paid employees are hit harder. Mayor Collins said we may need to use a hybrid approach. Alderman Pattillo said we need to do the four percent across the board raise and look at doing a salary schedule for the employees. Alderman Evans said I have concerns about the insurance. Alderman Curtis said we are giving a cost of living raise. He said the county maintenance workers are making less then our maintenance employees. The Board agreed to further discuss the budget at the regular June meeting.
